

North-West Deputy Regional Director Opportunity

CAMRA's North-West Region is recruiting a Deputy Regional Director, to report to the Regional Director (RD). The hours are to suit and can be fitted around other commitments and interests. The core tasks will be:

- Attending Branch, Area, Regional and National Meetings on the occasions where the RD is unable to attend (e.g. clash of dates). This is likely to be two or three times a year.
- Supporting the RD by meeting with Branches to resolve local issues.
- Answering queries on behalf of the RD when they are unavailable.
- Being another pair of "eyes and ears" around the Region, picking up any issues so that they can be dealt with as necessary.

Other tasks are outlined in the [Role Guidance Document](#). The most significant being:

- Supporting Branches and Area by attending meetings when you are able (you are most certainly not expected to attend all of them, more likely about 5-10% of them a year).
- Chairing Area Meetings when the Area Organiser/Co-ordinator is unavailable.
- Meet with the RD and the AOs/Cs as part of Regional Leadership meetings (occasional).
- Be on the Organising Committee of any Regional Level or National Beer Festival held in the Region.

Support is available from the RD and CAMRA staff, and expenses can be claimed in line with CAMRA's Volunteer Expenses Policy.
