- Organising and running the Regional Cider Pub (or Club) of the Year Competition. Most of
 the selection and judging will be done by the Branches, but you will be responsible for

 cider and perry as per our definition. You will be involved in the Area and Regional judging
 rounds directly.

Other tasks are outlined in the Role Guidance Document, including:

- Supporting Branches and Branch Cider officers with guidance and encouragement to promote cider and perry drinking in their pubs and clubs, as well as their Festivals.
- Keeping the Region up to date with new or lost outlets for cider/perry as well as local producers who can be supported.
- Organising and promoting cider and perry events in the Region, especially in connection with the National events in May and October.
- Fielding queries from Branches regarding cider and perry. You may not always know the answers, but there is a lot of support available.
